



**Dr Marianne Ek** is head of the Swedish pharmacopoeia commission and deputy head of the laboratory at the Medical Products Agency (MPA) in Uppsala, Sweden. She joined the MPA in 1983 as a pharmacist in the chemistry section and was later promoted to head of the chemistry section in 1991. Between 1991 and 2006, she held a number of senior positions at the MPA before being appointed deputy head of the laboratory in 2006. Dr. Ek has been a member of the Swedish pharmacopoeia commission since 1990, vice-chair between 1999 and 2001 and chair in 2002. She is responsible for Swedish pharmacopoeial activities since 1993. In 1995, she became a member of the Swedish delegation to the European Pharmacopoeia Commission. She was appointed head of the delegation in 1996 and has been an expert in group 9 and is an expert in groups 10B, P4 and the working party “Rules of Procedure”. She is also chair of the working party “P4BIO”. Dr. Ek also lectures at the University of Uppsala where she has been supervisor of students doing their undergraduate thesis. She is author of several scientific papers in international scientific journals and holds a PhD (1983) in chemistry and a BSc (1975) in chemistry, mathematics and physics from the University of Uppsala.
