Access to the venue

Public Transport - Bus

Take the Bus No. 110 or 112 from the city centre. The nearest bus stop to the Larus Event Center is: [Sirály utca](#). A single journey bus ticket costs 450 Ft (approximately 1.11 Euros). Ticket must be validated when boarding and are valid for 80 minutes. Ticket point of sale locations [HERE](#). Alternatively, please see below more information about the **BudapestGO** application.

You can purchase a single ticket on board the bus and it will cost 600 Ft (approximately 1.5 Euros). The exact amount of cash is required, as the driver will not give change.

Registration

All participants must register to access the conference and the meeting venue.

Access to the venue will be granted only to registered participants. You may be asked to show your ID or passport at the conference welcome desk upon arrival.

On-site participants can collect their badges upon arrival at the welcome desk in the venue. **Please note that badges are strictly personal and non-transferable.**

Transport in Budapest

From Budapest Airport to the City Centre

Bus

The **Bus Airport Express** is a public bus runs 24 hours a day and it connects Budapest airport with three areas in the city centre: [Kálvin tér](#), [Astoria](#) and [Déák Ferenc Tér](#) stations. The approximate duration of the trip is 30 to 40 minutes. A single journey ticket costs 2200 HUF (approximately 5.50 EUR). Tickets can be purchased at the Information Desk in the Arrivals Hall.
