Joint EDQM-USP International Symposium on 'Pharmaceutical Reference Standards'

Call for Submission of Posters

Deadline: 01 June 2026

If you would like to participate in the poster session, you must register for the symposium and submit an abstract that is aligned with the symposium theme.

Submission Rules & Guidelines

- A. Deadline for submission:** Abstracts must be finalised and submitted to the EDQM using the 'Poster Abstract Submission Form' by **01 June 2026**. It will not be edited or re-formatted by the EDQM. Submissions will not be edited or reformatted by the EDQM. Each abstract must reflect your own work or that of your institution. While there is no limit to the number of posters an author may submit, the total number accepted will depend on available space at the symposium.
- B. Proposal review and selection:** All submissions will be reviewed and evaluated by the Symposium Scientific Committee. The Committee reserves the right to request additional information, ask for changes to improve the presentation or decline a proposal if the Committee does not find it aligned with the symposium theme. All applicants will be notified via e-mail regarding the acceptance of their posters for presentation at the symposium.
- C. Assembling and dismantling:** Posters will be displayed from **Wednesday, 23 September 2026 to Thursday, 24 September 2026**, in the area adjacent to the conference room. Registered participants can bring their posters to the EDQM premises (symposium location) on the morning of 23 September, between 08:00 am and 09:00 am.

Upon arrival, each poster will be assigned a 'Poster Number'. Please ensure your poster is placed in the designated space corresponding to this number. The area provided for each poster measures 1m wide and 2m high. **Please remember to bring all the materials necessary to erect the poster.** Materials such as glue, adhesive Velcro tabs, nails, pins and thumbtacks are NOT suitable to attach the poster. However, double-sided tape, cello-tape and hooks can be used. All the posters must be removed by 17:00 on Thursday, 24 September 2026. The EDQM will not be responsible for the loss or damage of the posters after the end of the event. Posters not removed by this time will be discarded.

- D. Poster specifications:**

Position: Vertical.

Dimensions: Your poster should not exceed 90cm across x 170cm in length.

Poster materials: Your poster can be made from paper, cardboard or a synthetic support.

Language: English.

Poster text: There are no specifications for text/font size. Text should be of sufficient size for easy reading at a distance of 2 meters (between 16-20 point).

Text and images: On the poster you must indicate: Title, authors; Institution; Short description of the project. It is possible to insert graphics, tables, drawings and pictures.


Audio-visual equipment: none can be used in the poster area.

- E. Publication:** If you wish your poster abstract to be published on the EDQM's website, please submit a finalised A4 PDF file prior to your arrival. All manuscripts must be prepared in English and be free of grammatical, spelling and punctuation errors. You are welcome to prepare and distribute copies during the symposium. Please make sure your poster is thoroughly edited and proofread before submission. The EDQM reserves the right to publish the abstract.
