CESP: A simple and secure mechanism for exchange of information between stakeholders and recipients.

Features:

- Delivery system for all types of electronic submissions
- Accepts all submission types and includes mechanisms to handle resubmitting of updated information.
- Not dependent on submission standards, i.e. will accept eAF, eCTD, NeeS, vNeeS.
- One-way, from Industry to Regulator, with simple notification system.
- Can manage submissions of varying sizes.
- Eliminates the effort for handling CD/DVD submissions

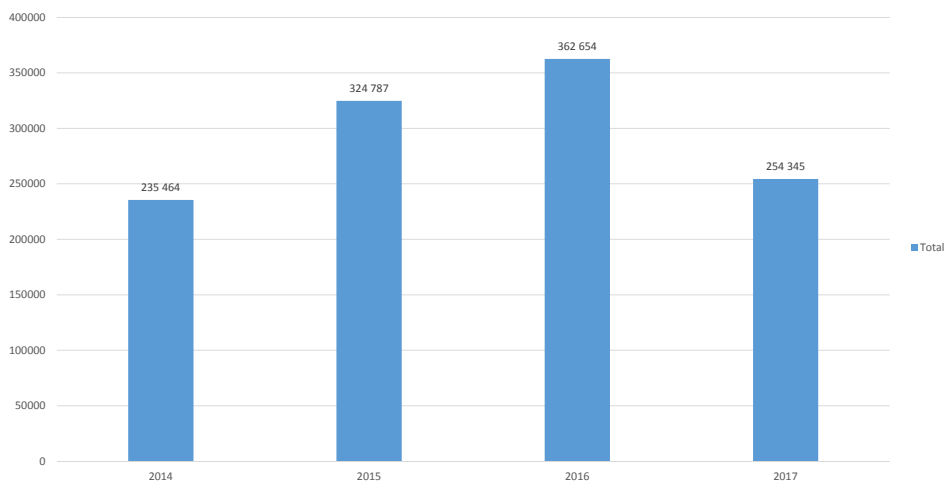

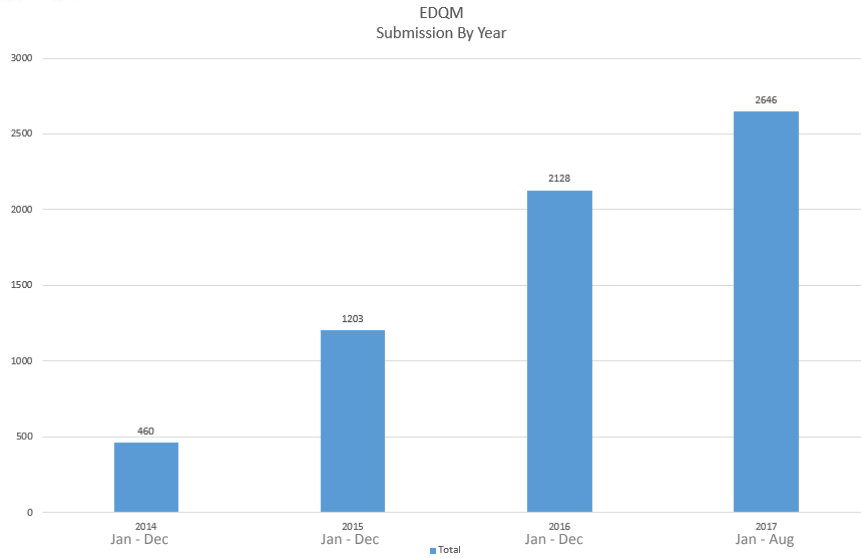


Overall Submissions By Year 2014 – 2017



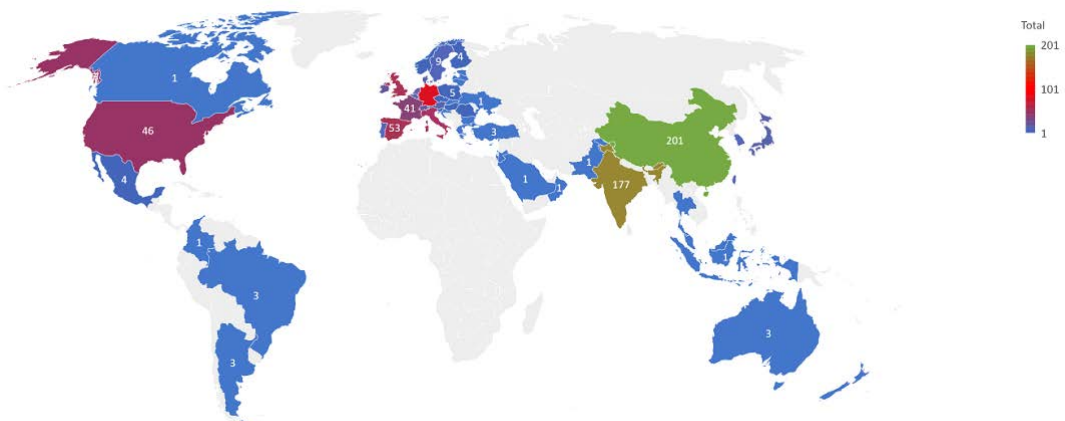


EDQM Submissions By Year 2014 to 2017

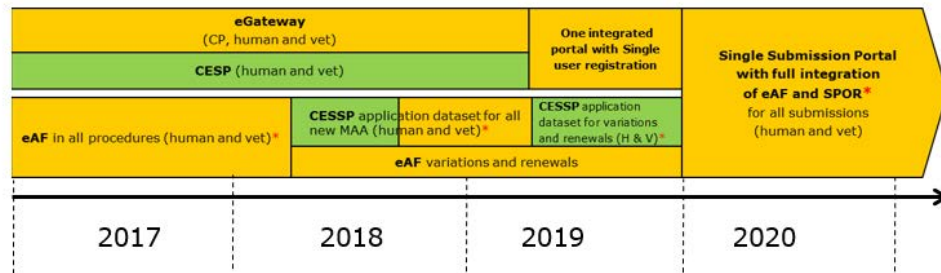

Typical EDQM Support Areas

Q: "I can't select EDQM when creating a delivery file."

A: To access EDQM via the CESP delivery file dropdown each organization must subscribe to the EDQM Area. This area can be added by a local Company Administrator via their Company Management area. Simply select the company name, select EDQM in the area list and save the change. The next time users for the given company access CESP the EDQM option will be available when creating a delivery file.

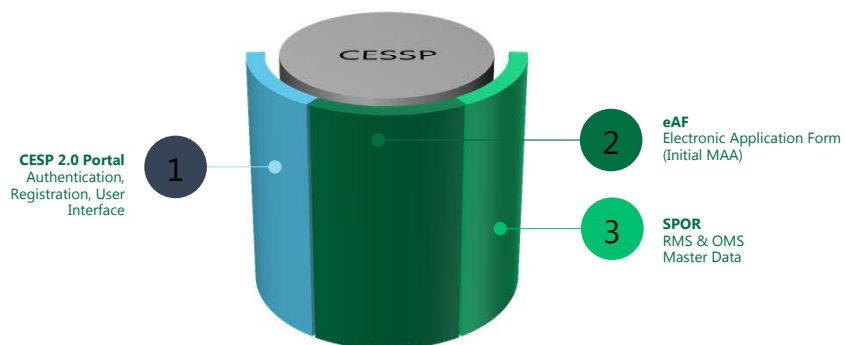
- Phase 1: Map and Sync Reference and Organizational Management Service

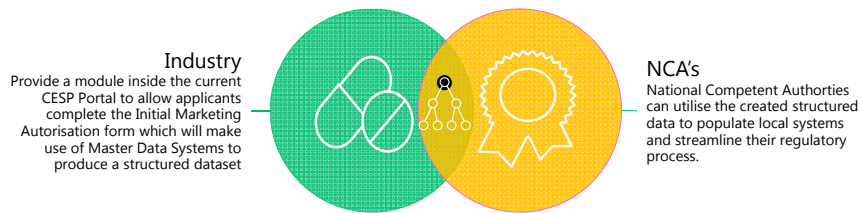
CESSP – Phase 1

Brings together 3 elements

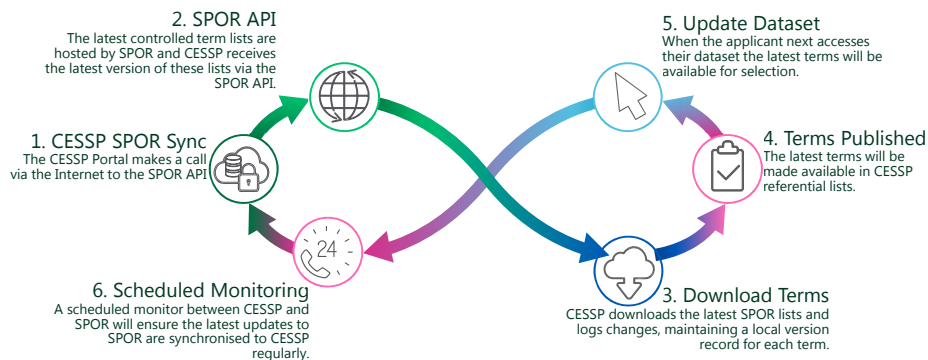


CESSP – Phase 1 Scope

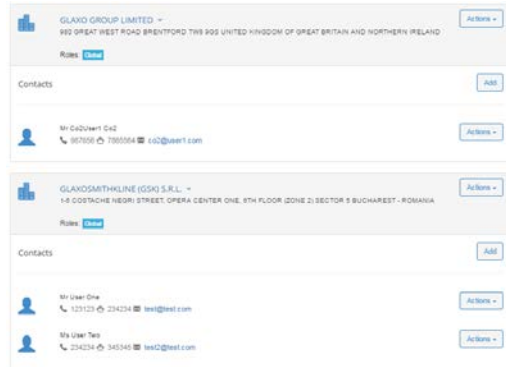
- Replace the eAF pdf for Initial MAA
- Create a streamlined online tool to provide XML structured data as the common language between Industry & NCA's
- Utilise RMS and OMS from SPOR

RMS and OMS


Are integrated into CESSP Phase 1. RMS will feed all standard dropdown lists inside the application while OMS will feed the new CESSP Address book where organisations can be added once and reused throughout the application. As the form requires contact information individual contacts for each organisation can be added in the address book and picked up in the application form as required. Allowing applicants to write once and use many times. The reuse of data should lead to better data quality and more efficient input and regulatory process.

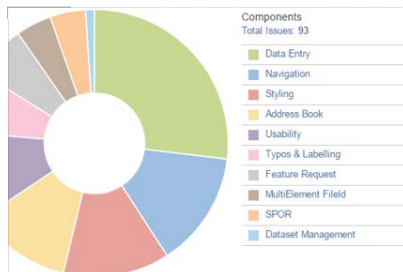

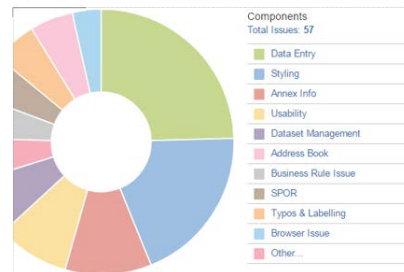

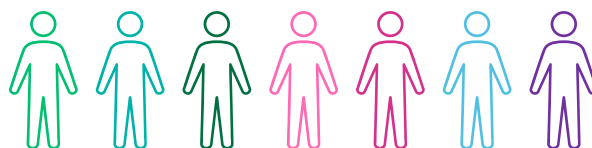
UAT#1 Communication & Feedback
